<b>House Mouse</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adult are 6.5-9 cm long</li> <li>• 12-30 grams in weight</li> <li>• Big ears</li> <li>• Big eyes</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prolific breeder</li> <li>• Sexually mature in 6 weeks</li> <li>• Litter size of 5-8 pups</li> <li>• Up to 8 litters per year</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Poor sense of sight</li> <li>• Cannot see clearly beyond 6 inches</li> <li>• Can jump vertically 12 inches</li> <li>• Excellent climbers; can easily scale rough walls</li> <li>• Capable of swimming</li> <li>• Droppings are 3-6 mm long and are pointed on one end</li> <li>• Can fall 8 feet without suffering injury</li> <li>• Can transmit disease from droppings and walking over our food</li> <li>• Feed at dusk and dawn</li> <li>• Mice are nocturnal in nature</li> <li>• Produce 50 droppings per day</li> <li>• Very curious animals; will inspect new things in their territory</li> <li>• Do not require to drink water as they can get enough water from their food</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can gain entry through holes 6 mm (1/4") and more</li> <li>• Common areas they infest in homes are basements, kitchens, garages, sheds and attics</li> <li>• Enter through gaps under doors, holes in walls or vents improperly screened</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Traps such as 'ketchalls', tin cats, glue boards, or snap traps</li> <li>• Use of rodent bait</li> <li>• Use of tracking powders</li> <li>• May take up to 14 days to see full effect of treatment</li> <li>• Good sanitation</li> <li>• Reduce clutter; fix holes and gaps they are entering through</li> </ul>
<b>Norway Rat</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 18-25 cm long</li> <li>• 200- 500 grams</li> <li>• Small ears</li> <li>• Small eyes</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reaches sexually maturity at 2-5 months</li> <li>• Gestation period of 23 days</li> <li>• 3-6 litters per year</li> <li>• 7-8 young per litter</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Droppings are 20 mm long; capsule shaped with blunt ends</li> <li>• Poor vision and colour blind</li> <li>• Good swimmers and climbers</li> <li>• Requires 15-30 ml of water a day separate from their food sources</li> <li>• Produce 30-180 droppings per day</li> <li>• Nocturnal in nature</li> <li>• Show fear of new objects in their territory</li> <li>• Prefer to burrow in the ground or nest close to the ground</li> <li>• Prefer meats, fish or cereal</li> <li>• Travel up to 150 ft. in search of food or water</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can gain entry through holes 3/4" or more</li> <li>• Commonly infest basements or garages</li> <li>• Gain access through gaps under doors, holes in walls, or vents improperly screened</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pre-baiting traps until feeding is evident then setting them</li> <li>• Use of rodent baits, especially water based baits</li> </ul>
